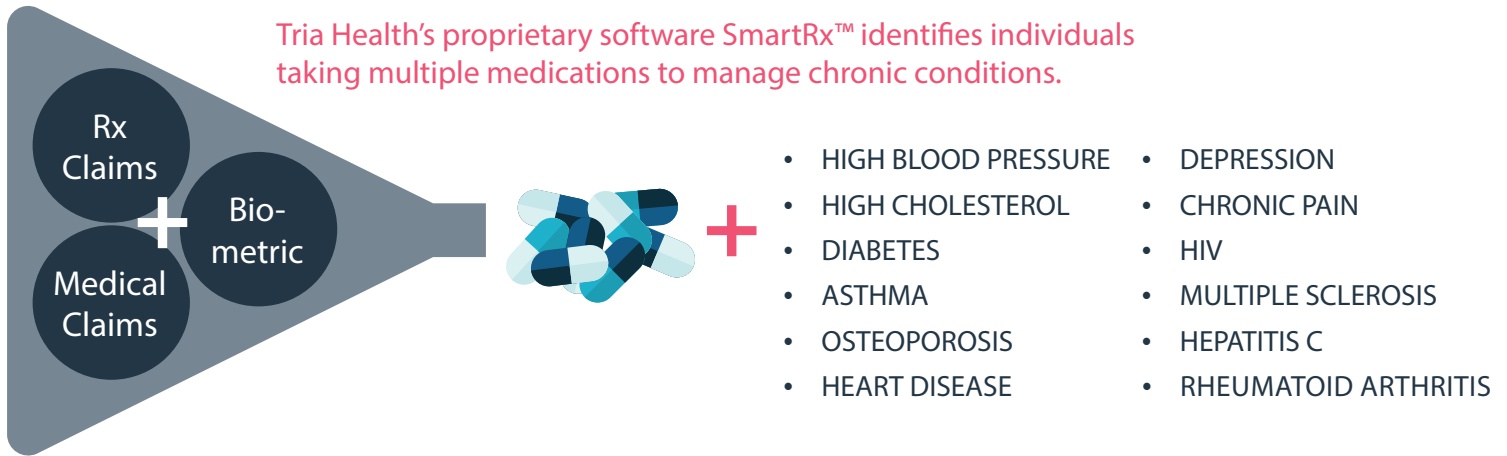

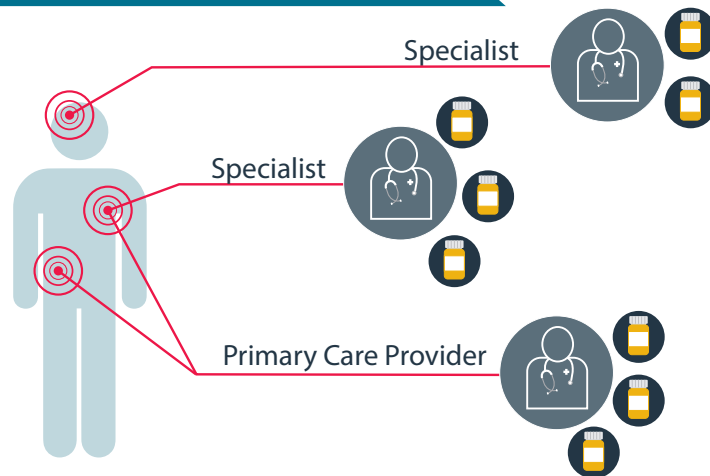

TRIA HEALTH DRIVES OUTCOMES

Medications: 8

Conditions: 4

- Diabetes
- Atrial Fibrillation
- High Blood Pressure
- Renal Disease - Requires dialysis 3 times per week

Identified Issue:

Patient is prescribed a medication for stroke prevention and atrial fibrillation that is unsafe for individuals on dialysis. This medication increases the risk of hospitalization and/or death from bleeding in dialysis.

Resolution:

Tria Pharmacist called the patient's physician regarding the unsafe medication. The physician switched the patient to a safe alternative.

Benefit:

- Hospital Visit Avoided -
Average Cost = \$29,046

Conditions: 3

- Diabetes
- High Cholesterol
- High Blood Pressure

Identified Issue:

Due to her history of heart attack, patient should be taking aspirin and statin therapy. She stopped taking the aspirin and never filled the statin prescription because it was too expensive.

Resolution:

Knowing the patient's plan design, the Tria Pharmacist recommended a generic statin that the patient would receive for free. Additionally, the Tria Pharmacist educated the patient on the importance of taking aspirin daily for heart attack prevention.

Benefit:

- Generic Substitution -
Annual Plan Savings = \$2,226
(Crestor - \$2,586 vs. Atorvastatin - \$360)
- Office Visit Avoided -
Average Cost = \$182

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
